REGULATION AND INSPECTION

St Wilfrids is registered and inspected by the Commission for Social Care Inspection (Care Quality Commission from April 2009) and operates under the guidelines of the National Minimum Care Standards. Inspection reports are available to residents and their families. In addition, there are visits by the Environmental Health Officer, Fire Officer and other associated regulators.

THE HOME

There are 36 light and airy bedrooms that offer a choice of accommodation to suit individual needs. The majority of the rooms have en-suite facilities, and all are fitted with a 'nurse call system and television point.

St Wilfrids has been both refurbished and extended. The new extension, the 'Helena Jeffrey' wing, has six rooms tastefully decorated, carpeted and furnished. Four of the rooms are en-suite and all have views of the gardens and/or hills.

Sophisticated fire and smoke detection systems are installed in the home for added peace of mind. A 'nurse call' system is fitted and there is always a nurse on hand 24 hours a day.
