REGULATION AND INSPECTION

As a clear demonstration of our commitment to provide quality care and services, the Caring Homes Group is ISO9001 accredited a quality standard for consistency in the delivery of quality services to our customers. The group also holds the coveted Institute of Hospitality award, an international standard pertaining to hospitality services.

VISITORS

We operate an 'open visiting' policy, and residents are welcome to receive visitors whenever they choose and they may stay for meals by prior arrangement and for a small fee. We encourage visits from family members and friends to ensure that they are completely happy with the environment and the care we provide. Visitors are welcome at any time during the day or evening, subject to the care and rest needs of individual residents.

Bradbury House is a charming period property built in the 1600s and has character

features throughout. The home is set in courtyard gardens, and enjoys a prime position close to the centre of Braintree. In this popular location residential care is provided to up to 21 people over the age of 65.

THE HOME

The desire to create a 'home from home' is uppermost in the minds of staff at Bradbury House, whom are dedicated in their compassion for the elderly. The combination of warmth and comfort, alongside friendship and support makes Bradbury House a real home. All residents have individual care plans and assessments to ensure that their choices and needs are met.

The home has period features throughout, including wooden beams and an inglenook fireplace in the comfortable sitting room, creating a cosy feel. Many pictures featuring a bygone era chosen by the residents adorn the walls of the home.

The home provides comfortable, bright and spacious accommodation, which is laid out over two floors, all fully accessible via lift. On the ground floor there is a reception area, a spacious lounge and dining room.

Bradbury House offers care to up to 21 residents in well appointed single rooms, many with en-suite facilities. All rooms are fully furnished and fitted with TV points. There is an emergency call system installed next to each bed for residents. All rooms are individually decorated and personalised, with residents' selecting the colour scheme and soft furnishings of their choice.

Outside, the courtyard gardens with a water feature, seasonal plants and patio areas provide a perfect venue for outdoor activities, such as sensory therapy, or to simply unwind and relax. Residents can also enjoy taking their meals outside in more clement weather.
