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Claydon House is an elegant Victorian property which has been completely refurbished to the highest standards. With delightful cottage gardens, it is quietly situated in one of the most sought after residential areas of Lewes. The home provides excellent residential, nursing and dementia care for older people. It is proud that it has the ability to provide a more seamless service based on the changing and ongoing needs of those within our care.

The transition into a care home can be challenging for both an individual and their family. THE HOME

Claydon House has been developed to provide a home for life with accommodation provided in the beautifully restored Edwardian House and the recently developed Admiralty wing.

The new Admiralty extension has been specially designed to support people who suffer from impaired memory and the inability to learn and remember, and to reduce stress caused as a result of dementia.

The 24 en-suite bedrooms in the extension provide comfortable, bright and spacious accommodation throughout the building. All rooms are furnished and decorated to a high standard.

Accommodation in the main building consists of 24 bedrooms, covering four floors, all fully accessible via lift. The home boasts two dining room facilities, in which residents can enjoy the freshly home prepared meals within an elegant dining facility. The lower ground has the addition of a beautiful conservatory and ramped access to the secluded garden.

Bedrooms can be arranged to suit individual needs. Sophisticated fire and smoke detection systems are installed in the home for added peace of mind. A 'nurse call' system is fitted and there is a nurse always on hand 24 hours a day.

PROFESSIONAL NURSING AND HEALTHCARE

At Claydon we pride ourselves on being able to provide comprehensive short and long-term packages, carefully designed to meet the needs of each individual.

On duty 24 hours a day, our dedicated multi-disciplined team provides high quality care appropriate to individual needs. Our key focus is in providing a safe, homely and supported environment with a positive person centred approach.

Residents are welcome to retain the services of their existing GP if this can be arranged. However, where this is not possible we provide visiting services from local doctors.

LIFESTYLE
