

LIFE AT DENHAM MANOR

NURSING HOME

Denham Manor is a privately owned nursing and residential care home set in three acres of beautiful grounds, in a private and secluded residential area. This magnificent country house is a typical gentleman's residence and is reputed to have once been a base for Sir Winston Churchill during World War II.

Denham itself is a small pretty village where both residents and visitors can avail themselves on the quaint tea shops, restaurants and inns. Although the village is surrounded by picturesque countryside commuting distance to central London is a convenient thirty minutes, with the M40, M4 and M25 very close at hand.

ACCOMMODATION

The fine house provides a gracious and warm welcome, with full nursing and social care for retired ladies and gentleman. The reception hall and main lounge offer very pleasant surroundings for reading, conversation and for residents to enjoy afternoon tea with their visitors. The dining room provides a spacious setting in which a high standard of cuisine can be enjoyed. Further day rooms include a television lounge, library, smoking room and spacious conservatories all of which provide splendid views overlooking the gardens, which consist of lawns, hedging, flowerbeds and copse.

All bedrooms have been individually and tastefully decorated offering private facilities. Each room enjoys views across the extensive grounds. The first floor is reached by an elegant staircase rising from the main hall, but for the less mobile there are fully automatic lifts to ensure that residents have the freedom of movement around the home.

CARE

It is the aim of everyone at Denham Manor to provide residents with both a comfortable and enjoyable home in very relaxed surroundings but with the special emphasis on nursing care.

Trained nurses and care assistants are supervised by our home manager, ensuring that the highest standards of nursing care are maintained at all times.

Medical care is provided by a local G.P. Practice who visit twice a week and at times when required. Referral for consultant advice is made as appropriate. Residents may retain their own G.P. if this is possible and agreeable. A fully fitted consultation and treatment room is available for the use of visiting G.P.s

We also benefit from a visiting chiropodist who visits the home every two weeks, and we can arrange under private consultation for therapists such as speech, physical and occupational to visit a resident if required.

FOOD & MEALTIMES

Our Chef and kitchen team aim to take residents individual needs and tastes into consideration, whilst presenting an excellent and varied cuisine. Residents are encouraged to breakfast in their rooms, whilst lunch and supper area served in the dining room. Coffee and afternoon tea is served in the lounges and conservatories and on sunnier days, on the garden terraces.
