## REGULATION AND INSPECTION

Inspector's reports are available to residents and their families. In addition, there are annual visits by the Environmental Health Organisation, Fire Officer, and other associated regulators.

## SHORT STAYS

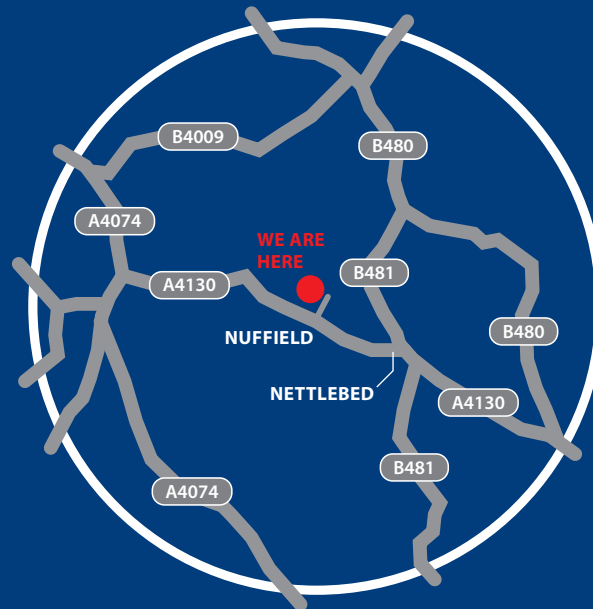
Subject to availability, we also welcome short-stay residents who simply wish to enjoy a break with us, require a period of convalescence, or wish to sample

## CARE HOME WITH NURSING

Huntercombe Hall is a stunning Victorian Manor House which has been sympathetically converted into a care home of distinction. It is located in the delightful village of Nuffield, close to the charming town of Wallingford and within a 15 minute drive from Henley on Thames.

Huntercombe Hall is surrounded by large landscaped gardens with level lawns with commanding views across open countryside and woodland. The homes' proximity to local services and facilities make it easily accessible, whilst benefiting from a rural location.

In this tranquil location residential care is provided to up to 48 people over the age of 60. It is our aim to provide a comfortable and enjoyable home with a friendly and companionable atmosphere, where residents can enjoy the highest standard of care from highly trained and qualified staff.

### THE HALL

This elegant home provides light and attractive accommodation over 2 floors with a grand sweeping oak staircase and lift linking the ground and first floor making all areas of the home easily accessible.

On the ground floor there are a number of luxurious communal areas including a panelled library. There is also a charming sitting room with large picture windows overlooking the gardens, a smaller more intimate sitting room which leads into the popular conservatory and a panelled dining room. All of the communal areas retain their original features, including period fireplaces, providing an elegant and spacious accommodation.

### PROFESSIONAL HEALTHCARE

Our key focus is in on providing a safe, homely and supported environment for those within our care, through a planned multidisciplinary team approach. We are fully committed to meeting the physical, psychological and spiritual needs of our residents to the greatest extent that their individual circumstances permit.

Under the management of the care home Manager tailored care plans are drawn up with residents on an individual basis in conjunction with their relatives. We aim to ensure that care delivery is discreet and appropriate, while also enabling residents to retain their privacy, independence and dignity. The plans are regularly reviewed so they can be adjusted as a person's needs change, ensuring appropriate care delivery at all times.

### SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT

The desire to create a 'home from home' is uppermost in the minds of staff at Huntercombe

Hall. All rooms are individually decorated and personalised, and residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings with them, to help them feel they are part of familiar surroundings.

We have a team of dedicated staff who are on hand to facilitate a residents every need from activities to outings, through to home cooked meals and social functions.

We provide a wide and varied range of meaningful 'In-House' activities. These may include traditional pastimes such as gardening, cookery, sewing, knitting and keep fit, through to more care related activities to stimulate the mind, body and soul, such as cognitive and sensory therapies.

Residents are encouraged to take their meals together in the dining room to foster a good social spirit, providing excellent opportunities for general interaction or simply catching up with friends.

Outside, the landscaped gardens also provide a venue for outdoor activities such as barbecues, sensory therapy and a place to simply unwind and relax.

### PRIVATE ROOMS

Huntercombe Hall offers care to 48 residents in well-appointed ensuite rooms, six of which offer companion accommodation if so wished. All are furnished to a high standard, once again retaining the period features that make this Victorian Manor such a luxurious setting in which to retire.

All rooms are fully furnished and fitted with telephone and TV points. There is an emergency nurse-call system installed next to each bed for residents to alert staff if required at any time of the day or night. For less mobile residents there is a stair climber.
