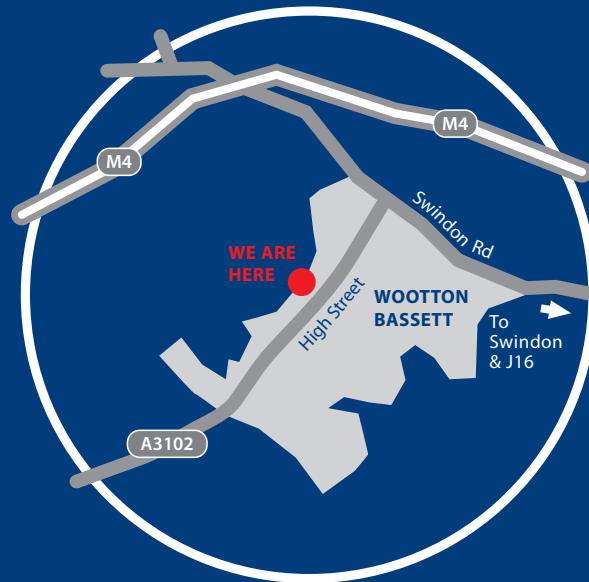
HEALTH AND SAFETY

CARE HOME WITH NURSING

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Miranda House is a modern purpose-built care home in the historic Wiltshire town of Wootton Bassett.

It has been carefully designed to provide the perfect environment for the specialised care of patients suffering from Alzheimer's disease and other forms of dementia. Located within walking distance of the distinctive broad high street.

The town has retained much of its architectural heritage, with notable Georgian buildings lining the high street. It is particularly well served with public houses – several of which date from the 17th and 18th centuries.

Wootton Bassett is easily accessible by road, being just two miles from the M4 motorway. It is also only a few minutes' drive from the nearby large town of Swindon, where there is a main-line railway station offering excellent links to London and Bristol.

Miranda House is registered with CSCI (Commission for Social Care Inspection) to provide support and professional nursing care to elderly people with dementia, and those under the age of 65 with enduring mental illness.

PROFESSIONAL NURSING AND HEALTHCARE

The home manager at Miranda House is a qualified registered nurse, with considerable experience in providing care and support to elderly people. A team of friendly dedicated staff support the manager, ensuring the continued well-being of the residents. Continuing training is a critical part of our environment, with more than half of the home's care staff being trained to NVQ Level 2 or 3.

Our staffing levels are regularly reviewed to ensure they are always appropriate to meet the needs of the residents at Miranda House. We provide a full 24-hour Registered Mental Nurse service supplemented by our experienced general nursing staff.

Miranda House provides a safe and supportive environment for the care of all its residents. We are fully committed to meeting the physical, psychological and spiritual needs of our residents to the greatest extent that their individual circumstances permit. We focus on promoting individuality, dignity and self-respect within our peaceful and comfortable surroundings, striving to provide the best possible quality of life allied to the highest degree of independence.

Tailored care plans are drawn up with residents on an individual basis in conjunction with their relatives to ensure that care delivery is discreet and appropriate, while also enabling residents to retain their privacy, independence and dignity. Medical care is also provided through arrangements with a group of local medical practitioners on a Medical Assistants basis. The plans are regularly reviewed so that they can be adjusted as a person's needs change – ensuring appropriate care delivery at all times.

THE SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT

The desire to create a 'home from home' is always uppermost in the minds of staff at Miranda House. Residents are encouraged to bring some of their own belongings with them, to help them feel they are part of familiar surroundings.

There is a large dining area, where residents are encouraged to take their meals together to foster a good social spirit, providing excellent opportunities for general interaction or simply catching up with friends.

Outside, the well-tended gardens have been landscaped to allow residents ample recreational facilities in peaceful surroundings, with plenty of outside seating for residents and visitors in the summer months.

PRIVATE ROOMS

Miranda House offers care for 68 residents in well-appointed single rooms – all of which have their own en-suite toilet and washing facility, TV point and a private telephone line if required. All rooms are fully furnished.

Special extra-wide corridors enable residents to move around freely and easily in spacious surroundings.

LIFESTYLE

Miranda House is registered with the Commission for Social Care Inspection (CSCI), and it has also earned the coveted Institute of Hospitality Assured Award, which reflects the home's strong customer focus and hospitality – this is an international standard usually more synonymous with the hotel trade.

Our fully qualified in-house chef plans and prepares all meals in an ultra-modern kitchen. A menu is created daily catering for all tastes, including special diets for physical conditions such as diabetes.
